There has been an change in diocesan law this week about Mass stipends. Presently the customary stipend to have a Mass offered for someone living or deceased is \$5.00, and it has been this amount for a very long time. Starting in July, the customary amount for a Mass stipend is going to be \$10.00. Everywhere else in our region has been at \$10.00 for many years, and we are the last ones to change this. Of course, those who are truly unable to afford this amount may ask for a Mass to be said for someone at a reduced amount or even for free and I, or any priest, would willingly oblige you. Masses are not bought or sold! The custom of giving a stipend is not about buying a Mass, but about showing gratitude for the graces received by sacrificial giving. Mass Stipends I have already received, will be honored at the present rate, meaning, you don't need to give more money for Mass requests that you have already made.

There will not be daily Mass on Tuesday this week. I am going to Crookston to concelebrate Mass with Bishop Cozzens on the occasion of his 25th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood. This is a momentous occasion in a priest's life, and everyone is invited to join the celebration. You are welcome and encouraged to come to the Mass at 6:30 p.m. at the Cathedral in Crookston on Tuesday.

The Ascension

The Ascension is the event, where Jesus arose into heaven, at the end of his time on earth.

Jesus' time on earth began with his birth. It was interrupted for three days by His death on the Cross. During that time, He descended into the realm of the dead and preached the Gospel to the good people who died before Him. This allowed those good and holy souls--the righteous dead, as we call them--who accepted Christ as their Savior to proceed to heaven. On the third day after his death and burial, Jesus Christ was raised from the dead, an event we call the Resurrection. He spent the

next 40 days preaching and preparing His disciples to perform the work of preaching and baptizing all people.

At the end of this 40 day period, Jesus ascended into heaven. We call this the Ascension.

The Bible tells us what happened on that day:

- 1. In my earlier work, Theophilus, I dealt with everything Jesus had done and taught from the beginning
- until the day he gave his instructions to the apostles he had chosen through the Holy Spirit, and was taken up to heaven.
- He had shown himself alive to them after his Passion by many demonstrations: for forty days he had continued to appear to them back page
