#### **MINUTES FOR October 2011**

The GSSN met on Wednesday, October 3, 2012, at the American Legion Hall in Henderson NV. President Ian Thaler called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM & led in pledging allegiance to the flag. He welcomed all - (there were 7 visitors & 64 signed in. Dara gave the Treasurer's report, following which Fred Zajac made a motion to approve the report as presented and Mark Hedges seconded the motion. It was so carried. Then Ian asked the group for a motion to approve the previous three months' minutes (5/2, 6/6 & 8/1, 2012) as published in the HighGrader and Fred such a motion, which was seconded by Pam Goulder. The motion carried. Next John Anderson, claims chairman, spoke about what he did on behalf of GSSN to file with the states of NV and AZ relative to our claims and then Ian spoke further about how we handled filing the claims the way John A. did because of the new fee structure (previously \$120 per claim; now \$140 for every 20 acres equaling \$\$1120). He explained that the Section 28 (White Hills) is now the "Lost Change" - Section 34 is now "Broken Step" - Dog Gone is "Empty Pockets" - and the Johnnie in Pahrump is now the "Pale Burro" - he elaborated on how these new names came to be. It was also noted that the Pale Burro is now a rectangle (per BLM's requirements. Ian also mentioned that the 20-Acre was not effected because it is not a claim - we own it. John Bronstein also provided additional information regarding this process following which there was a brief discussion to explain and clarify the GSSN claim committee's intense and precise efforts to insure the financial integrity of the club going forward successfully to maintain the secure status of the club's claims in AZ and NV. The group thanked all involved in making this complex process viable and successful. It was mentioned that next year fees should be substantially less due to small miners exemptions & other non-recurring expenses.

Next, Ian suggested that the Oct. outing be held at the 20-Acre on Oct. 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>, with potluck on Sat. & brunch on Sun. Outings are on NV time. Ian then asked Fred in the capacity of education chairman to act as election chairperson. Fred agreed and asked for two assistants. Morris Seguin, Leslie Burns, Marcel Gucu & Mark Hedges volunteered. The following nominations and seconds resulted: Marcel nominated Ian for president, seconded by Morris; Mark nominated John Roberts for vice president, seconded by Richard Harding; George Niederriter nominated Dara for treasurer, seconded by Pam Goulder; Doug Parke nominated Dolores Gee for secretary, seconded by Phillis Harding; George N. nominated Steve Christianson for membership officer, seconded by Richard Harding (pending Steve's acceptance since he was away). Elections will be next month. Following a short break, Ian gave a short power point presentation on "Where did gold come from...to be found at our claims" and there was a brief Q & A afterwards.

There being no New Business, the raffles were held next. Richard Gonzales won the \$14 door prize. The 50/50 in the amt. of \$32 was won by Dalin Frazier. Ian thanked all those who donated prizes to the raffle. Raffle winners are noted below. At 8:15 P.M. Pam made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Fred & the meeting ended at that time.
