Ladino Clover

Bombus is a large leafed, late maturing ladino clover and an excellent companion to Robust red clover in pastures and grazing mixes. While it does not handle heat or drought as well as Robust red clover, its stoloniferous growth habit allows it to persist in fields and pastures over long periods of time. Bombus was bred for more upright growth habit and improved disease resistance, resulting in more forage per acre and better persistence.

APPLICATION

- Excellent for frost seeding into pastures
- Excellent for reducing the toxic effect of E+ tall fescue
- Excellent component for high quality pasture

MANAGEMENT

- Seeding Rate (frost seeded): 3 - 4 pounds per acre
- Seeding Rate (drilled): 2 - 3 pounds per acre
- Planting Depth: 1/4—1/2 inch

FEATURES

- Excellent source of nitrogen
- Excellent seedling vigor
- Large leaves
- Tall and upright

- Provides nitrogen for pasture grasses
- Helps improve frost seed success
- Improves forage quality
