Alex Schneider Wins Greater Long Island Running Club Award

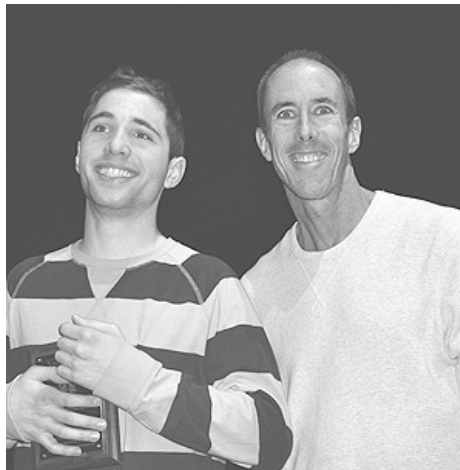
