

# Clinic Eligibility

## We may be able to help you if:

1. NO Pending charges or outstanding warrants
2. NOT currently on parole or have completed at least HALF of probation term;
3. You have your case information or CA State Department of Justice (DOJ) Rap Sheet / Livescan

## Eligible convictions may include:

- CA convictions only
- Convictions that resulted in jail time and/or probation
- Convictions where probation was NOT granted (sentence was jail or fine)
- Realigned 1170(h) convictions – split or straight sentences
- Felony convictions that resulted in state prison sentence prior to 2011 that now result in jail sentences under AB109 Realignment

The Clean Slate Clinic is staffed by volunteer attorneys, supervised law students and members of the community. You will receive legal information, NOT legal advice.

## How to Prepare

### 1. Get Your DOJ Rap Sheet

#### Community Livescan Services

offers fingerprinting onsite at the Clinic, by appointment only. See the next column for additional information or visit our website [www.sd-csc.org](http://www.sd-csc.org).

### 2. Find Out If You Owe Fines, Fees or Restitution

Contact the San Diego County Office of Revenue & Recovery at (619) 515-6200 and provide the clerk with your criminal case number(s). If you owe anything, please pay or initiate a payment plan to demonstrate to the court your commitment to fulfill your obligations.

### 3. What to Bring with You to the Clinic

- DOJ Rap Sheet / Case Information
- Recent Background Checks
- Receipts for payment of fines, fees or restitution / Payment history
- Proof of completed community service or court mandated programs
- Proof of Post-Conviction Accomplishments (education, work, volunteering, character letters)

## Get Your DOJ Rap Sheet / Livescan



### Community Livescan Services



offers fingerprinting onsite at the Clinic, **by appointment only**. When you arrive, please let the Reception desk know that you need Livescan Services so they can assign you an appointment time.

**Valid Government-Issued ID Required** – Expired IDs will NOT be accepted.

**DOJ Record Review Fee** – The DOJ charges \$25 for a copy of your Rap Sheet. Fee waivers are available if you are receiving government assistance or meet an income threshold.

**DOJ Fee Waiver** – To qualify, you must provide proof such as EBT card, Medi-Cal card, determination letter from SSI, Social Security, Disability or Unemployment, or paystub.

**Rolling Fee** – **Community Livescan Services** offers a reduced rolling fee of \$10 for those who qualify for the DOJ Fee Waiver, \$15 for those do not qualify, and \$25 for other types of fingerprinting services.

You should receive your Rap Sheet in 1-2 weeks. Call the DOJ at (916) 227-3835 with any questions.

## What to Expect at the Clinic

- The Clinic assists clients on a *first come, first serve* basis.
- The doors open at 10 am, but clients often arrive early to wait in line.
- Please be prepared to spend anywhere *from 2-4 hours at the clinic* as it will take time to review your eligibility, determine what types of relief may be available based on your criminal history, and assist you in preparing the court petitions.
- *Receiving assistance at the Clinic may require more than one visit.*
- Clinic clients that are asked to come back will be placed on a priority list for the following month.
- *We appreciate your patience.* We are all volunteers – we are all doing the best that we can, as fast as we can.
- *We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.*
