In Memory of;

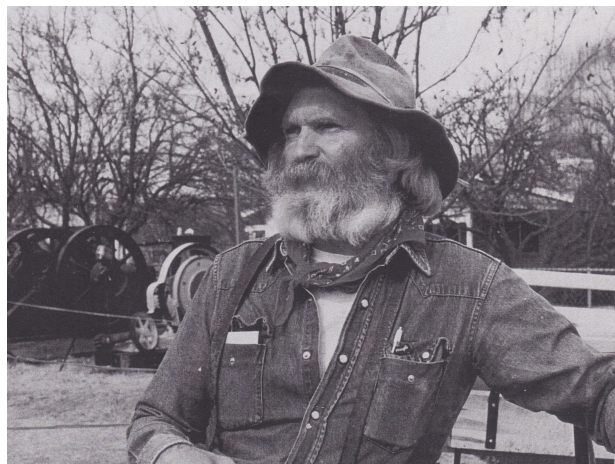
