GPAC Policy No. 002

JOAD and AAP Achievement Programs (Pin Program)

GPAC members may wish to participate in the USA Archery JOAD and AAP Achievement Programs. This program is voluntary and not required to participate in JOAD/AAP.

JOAD/AAP Star Pins are awarded for scoring achievements. JOAD/AAP archers can earn Stars Pins for shooting indoors and/or outdoors with recurve, simple compound and/or compound bows. Each Star Pin is a different color, and each has a successive number of stars on it to represent the increasing challenge in earning that particular award pin.

In addition to Star Pins, JOAD/AAP archers can earn the official "6-Gold" pin when they shoot six 10's in a row - either in a single 6 arrow end, or in two consecutive 3-arrow ends.

Per USA Archery rules: an "All Access" USA Archery Youth, Adult, or Family membership option is required to participate in the Achievement programs.

GPAC will allow those members with "Recreational" USA Archery Memberships to earn JOAD/AAP Star Pins 1 through 4 (Beginner Pins) before requiring "All Access" USA Archery Membership. After archers earn Star Pin 4, GPAC will require full membership status with USA Archery to earn Intermediate Pins 5 through 8 and Olympic Pins.

GPAC Members may earn pins at any club shoot where the Head Coach or Instructor has approved scoring for pins. GPAC members competing in USA Archery sanctioned tournaments may earn pins with scores from event. (One pin per round) Official scoring results from tournament must be turned in to GPAC Coach for pin award.

Completed score cards, signed by both archer and scorer must be turned in to Coach/Instructor at shoot. Score Cards must:

1. Be filled out completely with full name.
2. Scores must be clearly written.
3. Addition must be complete.
4. Both Archers must sign card.

If any GPAC Archer participates in another JOAD club's event or pin shoot and would like to earn pins while visiting that club, the Archer must coordinate with GPAC head coach prior to event. An example of this would be our members that also shoot with the Girl Scout's AIM JOAD group.

ARCHERS PARTICIPATING IN THE ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAMS ARE URGED TO BRING THEIR RIBBONS AND EARNED PINS TO ALL JOAD SHOOT.

Cost: Pins and lanyards are \$5/each.
