## January Project Snowman by Susan Kelley taught by Nancy Genetti



<u>Pattern</u> can be put on any size object. On the next page are several sizes. Feel free to reduce or enlarge to the size you want. It can be put on a box, round or square, small tray, jar lid, ornament, etc. Find something in your stash!

#### Palette: all Deco Art Americana

Jade Green, Wedgewood Blue, Burgundy Wine, Graphite, Summer Lilac, Blue Chiffon, Grape Juice, Lamp Black, Evergreen, Soft Black, Titanium White, Baby Pink and Dark Chocolate (substitute for colors you don't have. Since this is an older pattern Summer Lilac has been discontinued. You can mix it with 2 parts Orchid + 1 part Neutral Grey or use a color you would like.

<u>Brushes</u>: Bring a variety of brushes – flats, rounds, liners, mops, angle if you use them, large wash brush (about 34" if you have), a dry brush and a stencil brush or brush you like to stipple with. Brush size depends upon your surface size.

Bring normal painting supplies including grey graphite and stylus.

#### Prep before class:


Basecoat the background with Jade Green.

Transfer the wiggly line and paint inside it with Blue Chiffon

Transfer the Snowman to the surface and basecoat the snowman with Titanium White

Basecoat the hat with Graphite

Basecoat the scarf and hat band with Summer Lilac

#### 2016 Programs

In February Beth will be teaching the apron, "Housework Is For The Birds". She will have 6 white aprons for sale, \$10, at the January meeting. The first 6 to see her get the aprons. You can also grab aprons at Craft stores, restaurant supply stores and sometimes even WalMart. There will be some prep work before class so get your surfaces early. For those who would like a chicken wire stencil, see Laurie Speltz's website. She has them in stock. Several of us have stencils we can share but this is a big project for an evening class and you may want to get your wire done before class. Also, a lettering stencil can be used for the wording if you have one of those instead of brush lettering. Beth will be out of the country the week before the meeting so ask your questions asap. You won't get her the week before the meeting. The pattern will be in the newsletter next month.

And, in March Beth is teaching "Flopsy, Mopsy and . . . ", an acrylic piece painted on a scalloped landscaping stone. Start looking for the stones now and plan on prepping them with several coats of grey spray primer from WalMart. Since weather in a Texas spring is unpredictable, pick a sunny day and get it done early! The pattern will be published in newsletter later.


