

## OLSS TALENT SHOW

It's time for our awesome OLSS students to share their talents in our annual OLSS Talent Show! Students in all grades are welcome to perform. Acts will be recorded at school between May 10<sup>th</sup> and May 27<sup>th</sup> for virtual broadcast during the first week in June. Acts can include singing, magic tricks, dancing, martial arts, poetry, puppet theatre, instrumental performance, skits and more, just use your imagination and have fun! Parents and students should observe the following requirements and guidelines as they plan their acts:

1. The talent show is open to students in all grades. Students from different grades can perform together if they wish. Please return the attached permission form by May 10<sup>th</sup> if your child wishes to participate. All performers, including all members in a group act, must return the form.
2. All acts must be appropriate for a Catholic school setting, appropriate for all ages and safe for all performers. (Think G rating, with Jesus in the audience.) Parents, please guide your children to make appropriate choices in music and costumes. Students may assume a song is fine if it doesn't contain "bad" words, not realizing that the theme of the lyrics is not appropriate. If in doubt, choose another song. Acts not following these standards will not be recorded.
3. Costumes may be worn, but are not required. Students in group numbers should be mindful of cost and think of themes (matching color or style, all wear sunglasses, etc.) rather than feeling like they need to buy matching outfits. All costumes must be in keeping with our non-uniform code.
4. Students should plan and rehearse their acts at home. Acts will be recorded at school during the school day on the Chesapeake Room stage. Students in each act will be notified in advance of their recording day. Performers will have rehearsal time on stage before recording to get used to that setting, but should be well prepared ahead of time. Covid guidelines will be followed. Students will need to have props, costumes and any other items needed for their acts at school on their recording day. The acts will be compiled to create the talent show and will be broadcast during the school day in early June. We will let families know details about the broadcast day and time when we know how many students will be performing.
5. OLSS Talent Show participants and audience members have a wonderful tradition of demonstrating kindness, inclusiveness, and support for each performer. Please remind your child to be welcoming and encouraging to all group members in rehearsals and to celebrate the talents of all our amazing students. This will make our Talent Show fun and exciting for everybody.
