County Assessor Update

Our thanks to Assessor Leslie Davis for visiting the club, and reminding us of important dates regarding property taxes.

Those who have purchased a home in the last year, must file their homeowner exemption with the Assessors office by March 1st. Disabled Veteran exemptions must be filed by February 15th. This exemption is for 100% service related disabled Vets, and they must file for the exemption within 4 years of qualifying for the disability. Churches must file for exemptions by February 15th.

Due to Proposition 13, passed many years ago, California residents are taxed on 1% of the purchase price of the home, and 67 cents of every dollar goes to schools. Of the remaining amount, half goes to the state, and half goes to special districts, such as fire districts. Of the allocation sent to the state, it may or may not come back to the county. The state often takes money for state expenses.

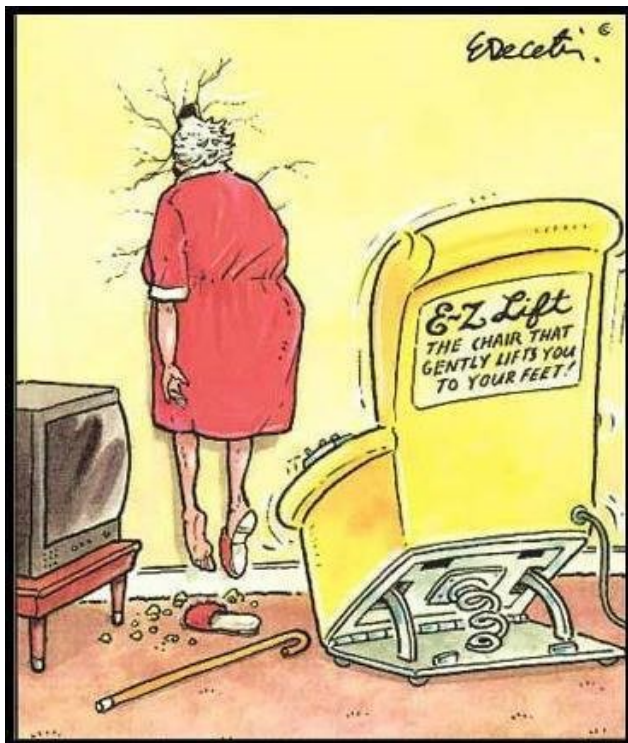
Business property statements are due April 1st.
