In addition, please ask your gardener to cut back any shrubbery that might be overgrowing the roadway obstructing clear visibility for motorists and pedestrians alike, particularly at intersections and blind or tight roadways. Additionally, the village security force has been ever-present and is at your disposal to make you feel safe and secure. The feedback from the NCPD is extremely positive and further adding to the active protection of the Village.
