16. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle to approve completion of Rye Patch and Elim Church Road to the LMIG Application. Commissioner Deloach seconded the motion. Commissioner Richardson opposed. Chairman Parker opposed. The motion passed 3-2.
17. Motion made by Commissioner Riddle to designate Joe Kennedy Road for the CDBG (Community Development Block Grant). Commissioner Deloach seconded the motion. Commissioner Richardson opposed stating that not everyone in the upper part of the county was uneducated and poor. The motion passed 4-1.
