FROM THE PASTOR: As you know, changes are coming for our parishes. Every parish in the Diocese of Saint Cloud will be part of an Area Catholic Community. These communities are comprised of two or more parishes that can gain substantial advantages by offering a more comprehensive set of pastoral services for their parishioners by being part of the group. What has been the planning process thus far? Bishop Kettler asked the planning council when looking at demographics and numbers to develop a plan for the diocese to be implemented in 2019. Priest focus groups began the process in the summer of 2017. Additional input was received from participants at the Diocesan Ministry Day workshop in September, at a Curia meeting, and fall deanery meetings with parish leadership representatives from every parish. In the spring of 2018, each parish was asked to hold discussions and submit recommendations. The planning council read through the over 650 submitted recommendations. Discerning and praying about the input from all of these discussions and studying work done from other dioceses the planning council discerned the concept of Area Catholic Communities. The parishes of Buckman, Pierz, Lastrup, and Harding have formed an Area Catholic Community at this time and meet monthly to discuss how to go forward in our area. More information will follow when available.

This weekend, we celebrate the <u>Feast of Pentecost</u> when the Holy Spirit came down on the disciples. All of us have been baptized into one and the same Spirit to strengthen us to go forth in the name of the Lord. May this same Spirit guide this committee and our parishioners to make good decisions for our Area Catholic Community. ~ Fr. Ken Popp
