Examination of Conscience

Several Sundays ago I taught the lesson from the International Bible Lesson Series in a class in our church. It was on the prophet Joel and was entitled "A Call to Repentance." Joel pled with his hearers: "Return to the Lord with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; rend your hearts and not your garments." He was calling for honest self-examination as a key to his people's relationship to God.

Several times during each Emmaus Walk in the devotional services we do what is called "an examination of conscience." That is traditional Christian spirituality language for looking at ones self in relationship to God, measuring where one is in their Christian walk, facing ones sins and need for God's forgiveness and healing. Every growing Christian practices, in one form or another, this spiritual discipline every day. It is essential to continued spiritual progress.

On two occasions a number of years ago my wife and I had the privilege of taking part in a Christian Ashram led by Dr. E. Stanley Jones. Dr. Jones was one of the great Christians of the 20th century – missionary to India, world evangelist. One night after one of the sessions, along with several other couples, we went to Howard Johnson's in Ocala, Florida to eat ice cream. Dr. Jones went with us. We had an enjoyable time fellowshipping and eating ice cream. As time passed it became obvious that Dr. Jones began to get more and more uneasy. He said, "Someone needs to take me to my room." We told him we would be going shortly but he was not satisfied. "I have to go now," he said. "It is quarter of ten and I have an appointment with the Lord at ten for He and I to evaluate my day. If someone cannot take me I will have to start walking." Brother Stanley was in his late 80s. Someone took him so that he could keep his appointment.

Many times since that incident I have thought: "If Dr. E. Stanley Jones needed to examine his day, who else does?" I need to – every day - examine myself, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, as to where I am in my relationship to Him, my service of Him and His purposes.

Greetings from YAC #38/Baltic Chrysalis #1 Jerry Keel, CAEW #21 (Table of Luke)

I never dreamed three (3) years ago when I was asked to represent the Southeastern states for Chrysalis that I would have the exciting opportunity to be a part of an International weekend. Sharlyn Gates asked me to be a part of this exciting weekend because of North Alabama's involvement. She thought it would be good for me, as North Alabama's Chrysalis Representative, to work hand in hand with their community.

Unfortunately, reality kicked in when she told me that The Upper Room would not be able to pay my way and that I would have to raise my own funds. I told her that I would have to pray about it and let her know.

The deadline to book the flight and my retirement from the Montgomery Police Department all came due at the same time. I had been hired by the State of Alabama but I had not been told my starting date as yet. Finally, I received notice that I was to start work on July 14, 2003. For me this was the answer to my prayers. I would go to Lithuania. Next I needed the finances. As I continued to pray about this, I sent an email to the Central Alabama Emmaus Community about the need for prayer, banners, agape, and financing for the trip.

Prayers were answered. We ended up with a banner for every talk (we don't even have that in our own Chrysalis Community); I took one large suitcase of nothing but agape from Central Alabama, and the money began to come in. There was always just what I needed when I needed it. The round trip air fare of \$1,529.70; gas for trips back and forth to Birmingham for team meetings; hotel fees in Lithuania for before and after the weekend; meals, camp fees, cost of sleeping bag at the camp, and transportation fees for a total of \$1,405.00. This came to an overall total of \$2,934.70. Thanks to the donations and gifts from churches, individuals from the Central Alabama Emmaus/Chrysalis Communities, Emmaus Clusters, Reunion Groups, and Sunday School classes I was able to raise \$3,327.00 which covered all of my expenses plus I was able to give \$100 to the North Alabama Chrysalis Community to help buy supplies for the weekend. I also gave \$300 to the new Baltic Chrysalis Community to help lay the foundation for their Baltic Chrysalis #2 next summer.
