An Interest in pistol shooting is being explored. One possibility could be shooting after "Sunday Shotguns".

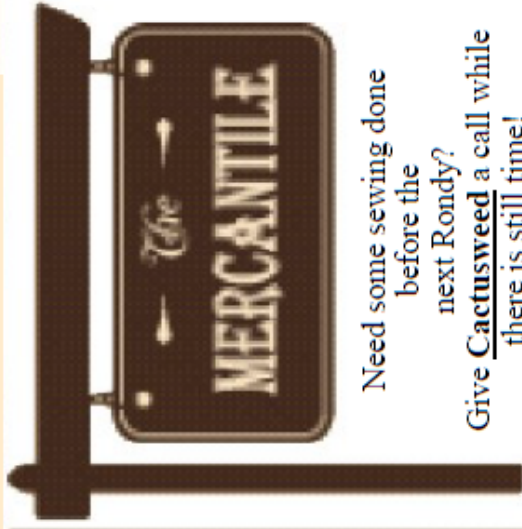
With Horse Ridge, Ponderosa, Forest Hills, Barlow and more on the horizon, some quality time practicing pistols could improve our presence.

Coffee Bean's Delicious Pecan Pie

After 3 eggs are well-beaten, add:
1 cup corn syrup, 1/2 cup sugar,
1-1/2 cup chopped pecans, 1 tsp. vanilla.

Beat together all ingredients and pour into a prepared pie crust.

Bake at 350° F about 40 minutes until the middle is still jiggly. Remove from oven, and let it finish cooking on the counter.

Pretty Flinchy's really Good 35 minute Goulash

1. Add 1 Tablespoon Olive Oil to large pot over medium heat. Add in:
1 cup diced Onion
1 diced green Bell Pepper
2 pounds lean Ground Beef

Then cook until beef is no longer pink. Drain any excess fat and return pot to stove top. Add in 3 teaspoons minced Garlic and stir until fragrant (about 30 seconds).

2. Pour in:
2 1.5oz cans Tomato Sauce,
2 1.5oz cans petite diced Tomatoes,
3 cups Beef Broth,
3 Tablespoons Worcestershire Sauce,
2 teaspoons Seasoned Salt,
2 Tablespoons Italian Seasoning,
3 Bay leaves,
2 cups Macaroni Noodles, uncooked.

Stir and bring mixture to a boil. Reduce heat to a light boil and stir occasionally until the pasta is tender, about 20 minutes.

3. Remove the Bay leaves and stir in 1 cup of shredded Cheddar Cheese just before serving. Enjoy!
