Gilbert Abbott Memorial Trophy - High Point Horse

General Rules

1. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of December 1, 2017.
2. All exhibitors must appear in proper attire.
3. All riders cannot ride anywhere on the showgrounds without wearing protective headgear passing ASTM-SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if headgear has a brim it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until their headgear is properly in place.
4. Cross entering between Pleasure classes and Hunter classes is permitted.
5. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary and to cancel or combine any classes if entries so warrant.
6. NO person will be allowed in the ring during judging unless on official business.
7. The State of Maryland requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months.
8. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in all divisions.
9. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
10. Entry Fee will be \$12.00 per class.

From Baltimore: From Route 695 take Route 795 which turns into Route 140 towards Westminster. Go 13 miles to Westminster and turn right on Route 97 North toward Gettysburg. Turn Right on Old Hanover Road and Right on Deep Run Road. Look for big white sign on left that says "Lehigh Riding Club", but turn Right at sign (private driveway up the hill).

From Gettysburg: Take Route 97 South and go straight through Littlestown. Turn Left on Old Hanover Road and Right on Deep Run Road. Look for big white sign on left that says "Lehigh Riding Club", but turn Right at sign (private driveway up the hill).

From Hanover: Take Route 116 which turns into Route 30 at the Maryland line. Turn Right on Deep Run Road. Look for big white sign that says "Lehigh Riding Club", but turn Left at sign (private driveway up the hill).

Lead Line Division

Open to riders 7 years of age and under. Riders to be mounted on ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged 50% on child's hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. No martingales. *Riders may also compete in the Mini Short Stirrup Walk and Walk-Halt classes.*

1. Lead Line - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk with leadline attached.
2. Lead Line Walk - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk with leadline unattached.

Mini Short Stirrup Division

Open to riders 9 years of age and under. Riders to be mounted on ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged 50% on child's hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. No martingales. *Riders may also compete in the Short Stirrup Walk-Trot class.*

3. Mini Short Stirrup Walk - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.
4. Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Halt - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and halt in one direction.
5. Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
6. Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot Over 4 X-Rails - To be shown over 4 x-rails.

Short Stirrup Equitation Division

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

7. Short Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. No martingales.
8. Short Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
9. Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over 6-8 fences 18" in height. Martingales permitted.

Long Stirrup Equitation Division

Open to riders 11 through 17 years. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

10. Long Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. No martingales.
11. Long Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
12. Long Stirrup Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over 6-8 fences 18" in height. Martingales permitted.

Beginner Adult Equitation Division

Open to riders 18 years of age and over in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

13. Beginner Adult Equitation Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. No martingales.
14. Beginner Adult Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
15. Beginner Adult Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over 6-8 fences 18" in height. Martingales permitted.

Crossrail Hunter Pony Division

Open to ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 16-17. Crossrail Hunter Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
18. Crossrail Hunter Pony Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Crossrail Hunter Horse Division

Open to horses. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 19-20. Crossrail Hunter Horse Over Fences - To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
21. Crossrail Hunter Horse Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Pleasure Horse/Pony Division

Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. No Martingales.

22. Pleasure Horse/Pony Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter.
23. Pleasure Horse/Pony Combo- To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot, canter. To jump 2 fences 2' in height.
24. Pleasure Horse/Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2' in height.

In order to receive Series End Awards, horse/pony/rider must have shown in 6 or more classes in the division.

Hopeful Hunter Division

Open to horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 25-26. Hopeful Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 crossrails 2' in height.
- 27. Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Children's Hunter Pony Division

Open to ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 28-29. Children's Hunter Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2'0" in height.
- 30. Children's Hunter Pony Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Open Equitation Division

Open to all riders. To be judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control. Additional tests may be given.

- 31. Open Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
- 32. Open Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2'-2'3" in height.

Schooling Hunter Division

Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 33-34. Schooling Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2'3" in height.
- 35. Schooling Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Special Hunter Division

Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 36-37. Special Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2'6" in height.
- 38. Special Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Children/Adult Hunter Division

Open to riders 17 years of age and under and Adult Amateurs on horses. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 39-40. Children/Adult Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2'6" in height.
- 41. Children/Adult Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Open Hunter Division

Open to horses. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 42-43. Open Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2'9"-3' in height.
- 44. Open Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

In order to receive Series End Awards, horse/pony/rider must have shown in 6 or more classes in the division.

Ribbon winners in each class will receive points according to the chart below.
