Seneschal's Report: Lord Edmond reported that things continue smoothly

Chatelaine Report: THL Aesa reported that it's been a quiet month – one info request for someone near Coille Stormeil

Exchequer's Report: Lady Eyfríðr reported that her quarterly was in and accepted, and that the checks were sent back for editing. General fund \$9723.00; rapier fund \$241.61; Bentbridge \$863.64; Norwealdmere \$0

Chronicler's Report: THL Marketa reported that the VI was out; position is up for voting this month

MoAS: Isolda reported that things continue to be quiet aside from dance and Bentbridge

Herald's Report: Lord Lazar reported that the paperwork for the Vert Sparkes badge was located and resubmitted

Knight's Marshal's Report: Lord Edmond reported that practices had been cancelled for the winter due to lack of site and instead carpooling planned to get to Jara practices. There has been discussion of adding armored practice to the rapier practices at new site but is pending marshal availability & communication with KM

Rapier Marshal's Report: Lord Brice reported that practice at Bentbridge continues and winter site for baronial practice will be at Crossroads Church on Monday nights at a cost of \$40/mo. A motion was made by Edmond to request donations from the attending fighters to cover this cost with any remainder being made up by the baronial rapier fund if necessary; motion seconded by Aesa and passed unanimously

Youth Combat Marshal: Lord Aeden reported that the next major opportunity for boffer will likely be Boar's Head

Archery Captain: Lord Ronin reported that practices have been cancelled for the winter. Carpool to Jara archery practice on Sundays may be an option.

Web Minister's Report: Lord Luca reported that the calender function was being upgraded and the forwarding addresses were being updated

Social Media Deputy's Report: THL Birna reported that Facebook group & pages were updated with the updated social media policy info per Kingdom. There is a new email alias for the social media officer. "This Week in Windhaven" will be posted weekly on Fridays.

Bentbridge: Lady Emerenciana reported that the Longhouse has been busy this month and they are working on attracting new members/officers

Norwealdmere: No report

Baron & Baroness Report: Their Excellencies reported that Crown went well and new heirs are secured with good media coverage. They will be attending SUN and TOC the following weekend,

with investitures coming up at Boar's Head & 12th Night.

Old Business:

- T-shirts: Isolda announced that we had an estimated 50 shirts spoken for, at a cost of \$600. Edmond made motion to set prices at \$15/tshirt and \$17/long sleeve shirt; motion seconded by Xanthippe and passed unanimously.
- Voting: Collette was voted into office as Chronicler and Lord Edmond was voted into office for a 1yr extension as Knights Marshal
- Coronets: Her Excellency reported that she was waiting on designs & estimates which will then be presented to the barony
- Wherefore Art Thou: Lord Edmond reported that the event had been cancelled due to a computer issue with the event site; the Girl Scouts are interested in making a second attempt at the event next spring.

New Business:

- Crown & Coronation bids: TRM are requesting any interested groups to submit bids for either of these events; bids may be for future events and not just the most immediate reign (up through 2019 & into 2020 if possible)
- Winter/Holiday Moot: THL Balthazar proposed a moot on Jan 12 at Village Hall in Howard from 10am – 10pm. Cost \$50 to rent hall. Sweets/holiday theme with dancing, caroling. Due to site rules, a basket for donations to cover site cost will be put out at meetings leading up to the moot but cannot be set out during the moot
