Tusten Comprehensive Plan Committee  
January 25, 2021

Chairperson Jane Luchsinger opened the meeting of the Tusten Comprehensive Plan Committee on January 25, 2021 at 6:32 pm.

Jane Luchsinger moved and Crystal Weston seconded a motion to accept the minutes of the January 11 meeting. All were in favor.

Consultant Manning distributed the draft of the entire comprehensive plan to committee members for review prior to the January 25th meeting.

Along with the committee, Manning reviewed the plan's recent updates, typos, corrections.

Jane Luchsinger requested that we clarify areas in the plan that referred to Narrowsburg and Tusten to avoid confusion between the hamlet and the Township.

Manning expressed his appreciation for the list of comments from the Sullivan County Planning Department as well as those from Code Officer Jim Crowley.

Jane Luchsinger confirmed that the Tusten Historical Society has a New York State charter.

Consultant Manning and Crystal Weston will work on the text relating to youth services and programs.

The next steps for the committee and plan is to establish the timing of the plan's review by the Town Board and release to, and public comment from, the public.
