NEWS OF OUR DEMISE HAVE BEEN GREATLY EXAGGERATED

Once again the media over reacts to the results in September when year-after-year we have seen championship teams struggle in September and sometimes in October, only to get things figured out in November. A few teams that had early season losses this season but now look pretty good include Stanford, Michigan, Wisconsin, Alabama, USC, Mississippi State and Penn State.

Stanford looked very strong in their 42-24 win over Oregon State. Don't look now but it's possible Stanford could be on the same path that Ohio State was on last season. The Cardinal lost early 16-6 at Northwestern but they have looked extremely impressive ever since. Mississippi State went to Jordan-Hare Stadium and beat Auburn 17-9. Dan Mullen's Bulldogs once again have a strong defense that should keep them in most of their games. After allowing 35 points to Alabama in their season opening loss to the Tide, Wisconsin has allowed just 3 points in the 3 games since and have looked very good. The Badgers shut out Hawaii the past Saturday, 28-0. Alabama bounced back from their home loss to Ole Miss with a solid 34-0 shutout over Louisiana-Monroe. Jim Harbaugh's Michigan Wolverines once again looked very sharp in beating Brigham Young 31-0. Penn State stumbled out of the blocks this season, but the Nittany Lions offense now seems to be on the same page after beating San Diego St last week 37-21. USC bounced back nicely from the loss to Stanford by dominating Arizona St 42-14.

There were other big games this past Saturday. Florida was 5 for 5 on 4th down in their dramatic 28-27 victory over Tennessee. This was the second loss this season when it appeared the Vols were in control of a game, only to see it slip through their fingertips. The same thing happened when Oklahoma beat Tennessee in Knoxville. For the second season in a row, Texas A&M beat Arkansas in OT. The Aggies tied the game 21-21 with a touchdown and a 2 point conversion, then won it 28-21 with another TD pass from Kyle Allen to Christian Kirk and a stop from their defense to remain undefeated. TCU stunned Texas Tech 55-52 with a tipped touchdown reception from Trevone Boykin to Aaron Green with just 23 seconds left. Duke beat Georgia Tech 34-20 and once again the Blue Devils seem to be much better than the experts predicted. A Pac-12 team that was also underrated when the season began is Utah. The Utes now own impressive wins over two good teams in Michigan and Oregon. They dominated Oregon 62-20 at Autzen Stadium and are now sitting at 4-0 on the season. Northwestern improved to 4-0 with a 24-19 win over Ball State. As good as Northwestern's defense has been, this season, their offense has been mediocre at best.

AROUND THE NATION

Notre Dame (4-0) travels to Death Valley to take on the Clemson Tigers (3-0). The Irish have lost several players to injury but they continue to play well while Clemson has had two weeks to prepare for Notre Dame. Miami, FL (3-0) is at Cincinnati (2-2). Gunner Kiel was knocked out the Memphis game so it could be Hayden Moore who starts at QB for the Bearcats The Pitt Panthers (2-1) are at Virginia Tech (2-2). Pitt was off last week after their tough loss to lowa while the Hokies try to rebound after losing to East Carolina. The undefeated Ohio State Buckeyes (4-0) are at the undefeated Indiana Hoosiers (4-0). OSU looked much better last week as they put their 17 game winning streak on the line vs the high scoring Hoosiers. Iowa (4-0) is at Wisconsin (3-1) in a key early season, Big Ten West Division, match-up of two teams playing very good football right now. Michigan (3-1) goes to Byrd Stadium to take on Maryland (2-2). Michigan looks strong and the Wolverines will be tough to beat. Minnesota (3-1) at Northwestern (4-0) is another high profile Big Ten West Division game. Ole Miss (4-0) goes to the Swamp to take on Florida (4-0) in a battle of SEC unbeatens Mississippi State (3-1) is at Texas A&M (4-0). It will be fun to watch the MSU defense vs the A&M offense. Arizona (3-1) goes to Stanford (3-1). We are believers in the Cardinal, so Arizona must play their best game to have a chance. Arizona State (2-2) is at UCLA (4-0). The Sun Devis could derail the Bruins run if they're not careful. Texas Tech (3-1) goes to Baylor (3-0) to try to slow down the high octane offense of the Bears. Kansas State (3-0) takes on Oklahoma State (4-0) in Stillwater. Both of these teams are flying under the radar for now. Finally, West Virginia (3-0) goes to Norman to take on Oklahoma (3-0). The Sooners better be ready for the Mountaineers or they could get ambushed

The Crimson Tide of Alabama (3-1) take on their neighbors to the east, the Georgia Bulldogs (4-0) in a game that has so many things at stake, it'd be impossible to list them all, in this limited space. Basically, this is a MUST win for Alabama if they want to be considered for one of the four teams in the College Football Playoffs. Psychologically this is a MUST win for Georgia as well. Their fans and fans across the nation still have doubts about this football team and a win would do wonders to squash the negative thoughts that anyone has about coach Mark Richt and his team.

Nick Saban has built a physical team at Alabama so they want to impose their will against their opponents when they can and RB Derrick Henry is the perfect fit for this smash mouth offense. If he has a big game it's difficult to imagine Alabama not winning. RB Nick Chubb has been dynamite for Georgia as well but Virginia transfer QB Greyson Lambert has played superbly and he is the key for Georgia's chances to win this game.

Amazingly, from 1978-2014 (37 years) these two SEC powers played just 11 times. Alabama leads the all-time series 37-25-4. Alabama also leads all-time in games played at Sanford Stadium 12-7-0. In the games where the winner won by a touchdown or less Georgia leads 10-9-4. Possibly the most memorable game these two have ever played was in the SEC Championship Game following the 2012 season when the Crimson Tide escaped with a 32-28 victory. We think that Alabama will come away with a close win.



COLLEGE FOOTBALL HIDDEN GEMS: ARMY'S MICHIE STADIUM



Michie Stadium, located on the campus of the United States Military Academy in West Point, NY is the home to Army football. It was named after Dennis Michie who had a big part in starting the football program when he was a cadet at the Academy in the 1890's. Six years after he graduated, he was killed in San Juan, Cuba during the Spanish-American War.

Michie Stadium opened in 1924 and overlooks the Hudson River. It has only had a few expansions in it's long history. In 1962 the permanent east grandstands were constructed but they were not built too big to obstruct the views on the Hudson River that flows behind them. In 1969 the west upper deck was built and in 2003 the old press box was replaced by the current one. The current seating capacity is 38,000.

Amazingly, the Army-Navy game has been played at Michie Stadium just once and that was during WWII when it was felt it was better to play there than at the much larger Municipal Stadium in Philadelphia.

Over the past 10-20 years there have been several publications/websites that have ranked the best college football stadiums in the country. Inevitably, those lists will include Michie Stadium. Most of those lists, rate Michie Stadium as the most beautiful stadium in college football. Unfortunately, very few "big" games in a given season involve Army, thus very few college football fans ever get to see Michie Stadium, but for those who have, will agree that Michie Stadium as the most picturesque in the land.

This week THE BLITZ remembers the great Paul W. "Bear" Bryant. Coach Bryant is best remembered as the head coach of Alabama but he began his head coaching career at the University of Maryland when the Terrapins were in the Southern Conference. He stayed there for just 1 season before becoming the head coach at the University of Kentucky from 1946-1953. Bear Bryant is STILL the winningest head coach in Kentucky history with 60 wins and led the Wildcats to 4 bowl appearances and 1 SEC title. In 1954 he became the head coach at Texas A&M. He guided the Aggies to the Southwest Conference title in 1956. Finally in 1958 his alma mater called and it was off to Alabama where he stayed for 25 years. While at Alabama, his Crimson Tide teams claimed 6 National Championships (1961; 1964; 1965; 1973; 1978; 1979) and 13 SEC titles. After missing a bowl in his first season in Tuscaloosa, Bear Bryant coached his teams to 24 consecutive bowl appearances from 1959-1982.

A lot of his former players had wonderful things to say about coach Bryant as did many men who were also head coaches when Bryant was. The late Bum Phillips made a profound statement that only coach Phillips could say and get away with. He said about the Bear, "Bryant can take his'n and beat your'n, and then he can turn around and take you'n and beat his'n." Former USC head coach John McKay made the ultimate compliment when he said about Bryant "He wasn't just a coach. He was THE coach.

No former coach is loved more than Bryant is at Alabama. Penn State fans will argue that statement with how they feel about Joe Paterno and Ohio State fans still adore Woody Hayes but Bear Bryant is absolutely beloved by the Crimson Tide fans so much that they have adopted his famous "houndstooth" fedora hat pattern on everything these days in the state of Alabama.
