

**Sergeant Cari A. Gasiewicz, USA (Depew, NY, 28 years)**

202nd Military Intelligence Battalion, 513th Military Intelligence Brigade, Fort Gordon, GA

Died: 4 Dec 04, Baqubah, Iraq

SGT Gasiewicz was an interpreter. She died when two improvised explosive devices detonated near her convoy, one month before she was scheduled to redeploy to the US. She left behind her parents and a brother.

**Sergeant Tina S. Time, USAR (Tucson, AZ, 22 years)**

208<sup>th</sup> Transportation Company, Tucson, AZ

Died: 13 Dec 04, near Cedar, Iraq

SGT Time, a vehicle mechanic, died when the supply truck she was in collided with another vehicle during a dust storm. She was two months away from completing her tour in Iraq. She left behind her mother and three siblings, all serving in the military.

**Sergeant Jessica M. Housby, IL ARNG (Rock Island, IL, 23 years)**

1644th Transportation Company, Rock Falls, IL

Died: 9 Feb 05, in Route Golden, Iraq

SGT Housby died when an improvised explosive device detonated near her supply convoy outside of Baghdad. She loved serving in the military and wanted to do so since high school where she was recognized as the top cadet out of nearly 200 participants in a training exercise at the local armory. She was still in high school when she enlisted in the National Guard.

**Specialist Katrina L. Bell-Johnson, USA (Orangeburg, SC, 32 years)**

418th Transportation Company, 180th Transportation Battalion, Fort Hood, TX

Died: 16 Feb 05 in Ba'qubah, Iraq

SPC Bell-Johnson died when she was involved in a vehicle accident. She was known as "Buttercup". She left for Iraq two months after giving birth to a daughter.

**Specialist Lizbeth Robles, USA (Vega Baja, PR, 31 years)**

360th Transportation Company, 68th Corps Support Battalion, Fort Carson, CO

Died: 1 Mar 05 at the 228th Command Support Hospital in Tikrit, Iraq

SPC Robles died from injuries sustained in a military vehicle accident that occurred Feb. 28 in Bayji, Iraq. This was her second tour in Iraq where she served as a fuel provider. She enjoyed driving trucks and tankers. Robles, like so many others, joined the Armed Forces of the United States as a result of the events on September 11, 2001.

**Specialist Adriana N. Salem, USA (Elk Grove Village, IL, 21 years)**

3rd Forward Support Battalion, Division Support Command, 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, GA

Died: 4 Mar 05 in Remagen, Iraq

SPC Salem died when her military vehicle rolled over near Tikrit, Iraq. She graduated from Elk Grove High School and enlisted in the army after September 11. She was a dedicated athlete in high school, known to be at the gym to run and workout before school

**Specialist Aleina RamirezGonzalez, USA (Hormigueros, PR, 33 years)**

3rd Brigade Troop Battalion, 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, GA

Died: 15 Apr 05 in Tikrit, Iraq

SPC Ramirez Gonzalez, originally from Puerto Rico, died when a mortar struck her forward operating base.
