

1. Go to <https://www.sar.org/genealogy/patriot-search>
2. Please scroll down to the bottom of a short explanation about the Index.
3. Click on “**SAR Patriot & Grave Index**”.
4. That will open a new window. At the top it will say: Welcome to the National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution Patriot & Grave Index.”
5. At the bottom, in blue, click on “Search the Patriot & Grave Index”.
6. I have found that using less information is better than more information.
7. I only typed in my Ancestors Last Name “Harris” and his First Name “James”. This is what I found.



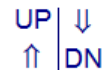
