

For several weeks now we explored Job's tragic circumstances. He lost his livestock, his children, and several buildings, and on top of that even his wife tells him to "curse God and die." (Job 2:9). Throughout this ordeal, Job's friends attempt to explain why God brought such tragedy upon Job, but they were foolish in their words.

So what makes this story so important? Job's faith never waivers. Yes he questions God and shares his anger with God, but his faith never waivers. In Mark 10 Jesus heals

the blind man by saying, "your faith has made you well." (Mark 10:52). In the same way Job is healed and blessed even more than before.

Jesus sits at God's right hand and intercedes for us as a priest forever. Our faith in Jesus results in our being blessed by God. We may not get riches, but what Jesus holds for us far exceeds our wildest dreams.

No matter what you go through, do not lose hope, that glorious hope that only comes through faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior.
