For the 2013 LVDGC Bag Tag season the club will be adopting a "sandbagger" policy. The goal of this policy is to drive the competitive nature of our sport and create a more comfortable environment for lower skill level players. When players enter into brackets beneath their skill level or win a division in multiple years and out score that field by large gaps it creates animosity among the participants of that group and a feeling of an unfair advantage. The players being out scored then feel less inclined to participate. As board members and players we take on the responsibility of promoting the sport of disc golf and cannot in good conscience let this activity affect our fellow players. This policy will have no affect on PDGA sanctioned events as they already have rules in place on this matter.

2013 LVDGC BAG TAG "Sandbagger" Policy

Amateur players that are declared winners in their division for prior years **Bag Tag** events are required to enter into a higher division for the following year, up to the amateur advanced division.

^{*}Players are not required to move from amateur to open divisions.
