"Life is Worth Living."

The above title should be familiar to all of you that remember Bishop Fulton Sheen. "Life is worth Living" was the title to his TV show (also one of his books) that aired from 1952- 57. He won an Emmy for his show and thanked his writers- "Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John." He expressed the Catholic faith in a way for everyone to understand and he did it with wisdom and wit. You can watch old episodes of his show on EWTN.

Bishop Sheen also wrote nearly 70 books including "Treasures in Clay", "Three to Get Married", "The Priest is not His Own", and "Go to Heaven." I imagine most if not all of his books are still in print so go ahead and read at least one of them. Bishop Sheen made it a practice to have a daily Holy Hour for all 60 years of his priesthood, "even dying in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the private chapel of his residence on Dec. 9, 1979 (Our Sunday Visitor)."

Bishop Sheen was recently beatified, which means he is one miracle away from being declared a saint. "Sheen's beatification comes after a formal investigation and approval of a miracle attributed to his intercession, which affected newborn James Fulton Engstrom, who spent the first 61 minutes of his life breathless, without a pulse. Having turned to Sheen for support throughout her pregnancy, the boy's mother, Bonnie, prayed for the archbishop's assistance. And just as he was about to be declared dead, her son's heart rate sprang to a normal rate. Today, he's a healthy, thriving 8-year-old. The miracle was approved by Pope Francis on July 5, 2019, and signals that his beatification likely will take place in the coming year (Our Sunday Visitor, Sep. pg.11)."There is a book out that tells the story of this miracle entitled- "61 Minutes to a Miracle: Fulton Sheen and a True Story of the Impossible."

Bishop Fulton Sheen's love of Christ and enthusiasm for the Catholic faith converted a lot of people and showed the Catholic Church in a very positive light. His TV show reached almost 30 million people and showed that society needed God in it to make it good. In our current culture, some people want to move towards socialism, which has never worked anywhere in the world. Socialism and Communism seek to remove God from the culture and Bishop Fulton Sheen fought hard against Communism.

I hope all of us can soon see Bishop Fulton Sheen declared a saint. He was a man who knew how to communicate the love of Christ to the masses. And may we all realize that 'Life is worth Living' when God is at the center of it!


