

Tenant Insurance and Responsibility Form For Vendor – Boat Worker Access to Lowrie Yacht Harbor, Inc.

As a requirement for vendor – boat worker access to Lowrie Yacht Harbor, Inc. we must have one of two documents completely filled out and signed.

- 1) Lowrie Yacht Harbor, Inc. offices must receive a certificate of insurance from the vendor – boat worker naming Lowrie Yacht Harbor, Inc. as “Additional insured” with a minimum liability limit of \$1 million.

Or

- 2) Lowrie Yacht Harbor, Inc. offices must have this document signed by the tenant as well as the vendor – boat worker assuming full responsibility for the vendor – boat worker and any damages or suits that may occur as a result of their presence at the harbor.
