Both males and females wear a white T-shirt, black neckerchief, plastic name tag (on right), ribbons (on left), and the gold-on-black NSCC flash with gold frame on both sleeves.

Except for AR (E-1) (who don't wear any), rating badges are worn on right sleeve.

This is only a summer uniform.

### NSCC Dress Blues (current)



Females currently wear the white combination cover (Pill Box) with the  $1-\frac{1}{2}$ " NSCC cap device.



Males wear the white hat (Dixie Cu without any insignia.

Shoes are <u>black</u> with black socks.

Males wear a white T-shirt and black neckerchief. Both wear plastic name tag (on right), ribbons (on left), and the gold-on-black NSCC flash with gold frame on both sleeves.

Rating badges are worn on right sleeve.

A silver embroidered "USNSCC" tape is sewn immediately above the left breast pocket, covering the width of the pocket.



A silver embroidered name tape is sewn immediately above the right breast pocket, covering the width of the pocket.



A second name tape is sewn above the right rear pants pockets, and a third on the left pocket flap of the parka.

Centered on the left breast pocket is the Anchor, Constitution, and Eagle (ACE), embroidered by the manufacturer.

# Name tape on Parka





A full size name tape (silver for cadets E-6 or below, gold for E-7 and above) is sewn on the pocket flap of the left sleeve.



The name tape extends flush to both sides of the pocket flap, and sits ¼" above the bottom of the flap.
