 Matthew 6:1-4 says, "Be careful not to do your acts of righteousness before men, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven. So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you."

One of the principles Jesus taught His disciples was anonymous servanthood. It is also one of the foundational principles behind the Walk to Emmaus. Each time I work a walk, I am amazed by the number and variety of anonymous servants who serve behind the scenes. It seems that each weekend I become aware of more anonymous servants who serve so faithfully. Even though they may be unseen by the pilgrims, our Father is watching. I firmly believe that anonymous servanthood puts a smile on God's face. He sees what is done in secret, and the reward we will receive from Him is far more valuable than the accolades of men.

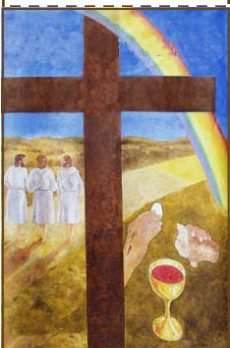
