- Clinical expectations and responsibilities for Primary Care Paramedics are based on the current National Occupational Competency Profile (NOCP), the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics registration requirements and Medavie Health Services West policies, procedures, and protocols.

**As the ideal candidate for this role, you will have:**

- Must meet all legislated requirements for Primary Care Paramedics in Saskatchewan.
- Must be currently registered with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics as a Primary Care Paramedic or eligible for registration through the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics. Candidates with restricted licences will be considered, with preference to those with unrestricted licences.
- Must be in good standing with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics.
- Must submit a copy (front and back) of a valid Saskatchewan Class 4 Driver's Licence (or equivalent).
- Must submit a current ITLS and CPR C for Health Care Providers which must be valid until the end of 2022.
- Must submit a current (within last 30 days) valid and clean criminal record check.
- Must submit a current (within last 30 days) driver's abstract.
- Must demonstrate the ability to work efficiently as a member of the team and possess strong interpersonal skills.
- Must be able to work all shifts as assigned, maintaining a good attendance record.
- Must have a high regard for confidentiality.
- Must have excellent work habits and exhibit professionalism
