

# ALAN V. STRONG

## 1910 - 1986

Alan V. Strong, 86 and resident of Lake Township near Cassville, died at his home Sunday, June 23.

He was born June 18, 1910, at Sault Ste. Marie, the son of the late Sidney D. and Alice (Vincent) Strong.

Mr. Strong and Dorothy C. Carley were married Jan. 5, 1938. She preceded him in death May 8, 1980. He later married Betty (Childs) King on May 23, 1982.
