
# THE BIBLE PROJECT 2.0

### **God's PROJECT RESET**

**Genesis 12-17** 



BIG IDEA 1: GOD PLANS FOR THE RESCUE OF THE WHOLE WORLD - HE IS STILL WORKING ON HIS PROJECT



God's aims have not changed—but now he has a different STRATEGY. His aims are still universal.

## **God's project:** To create a world where his will is done, all creatures live in joyous concert and all fellowship fully with their Creator.

This is the Foundation of the ALL of Scripture. GOD ALWAYS MEANS TO INCLUDE

**EVERYONE.** BUT now he adopts a geographic strategy. Canaan is at the hub of the whole world. See above picture.

Geologically Canaan is at the focus of the Jordan Rift that extends down to Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe. For example the African fish tilapia is the "St. Peter's fish" found in the Sea of Galilee. Confluence of the continents.

#### **BIG IDEA 2: GOD ESTABLISHES COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM**

Covenant Form THE REASON TO EMPHASIZE THE HITTITE COVENANT FORM IS TO ESTABLISH THE UNILATERAL IMPOSITION OF THE TREATY/COVENANT. THIS IS NOT A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT, BUT THE IMPOSTITION OF TERMS.

Berith is unilateral: God makes the relationship; man fits into it.

• Promise I will bless you

• Obligation so that you will be a blessing

• Promise/prophecy by you all the nations of the earth shall be blessed.

"Nations" = "Gentiles" MISHPOCHOT/ETHNE/GENS Hebrew/Greek/Latin

God intends Israel to BLESS the Gentiles. Right from the beginning.

THIS IS A REVOLUTION IN OUR THINKING ABOUT THE OLD TESTAMENT.

BUT Israel inverts the horn of plenty for the Gentiles and makes it a funnel for Israel to receive the blessings.

- 2. Abram
- 3. Israel Sinai (Mosaic)
- 4. Davidic basis for kingship
- 5. Jeremiah "new covenant" because God's people have broken the first after the exile
- 6. New Covenant in Jesus

#### Read and explain Genesis 15

#### <sup>6</sup> Abram believed the Lord, and he [the Lord] credited it to him [Abram] as righteousness.

<sup>12</sup> As the sun was setting, Abram fell into a deep sleep, and a thick and dreadful darkness came over him. <sup>13</sup> Then the Lord said to him, "Know for certain that for four hundred years your descendants will be strangers in a country not their own and that they will be enslaved and mistreated there. <sup>14</sup> But I will punish the nation they serve as slaves, and afterward they will come out with great possessions. <sup>15</sup> You, however, will go to your ancestors in peace and be buried at a good old age. <sup>16</sup> In the fourth generation your descendants will come back here, for the sin of the Amorites has not yet reached its full measure."

<sup>17</sup>When the sun had set and darkness had fallen, a smoking firepot with a blazing torch appeared and passed between the pieces. <sup>18</sup> On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram and said, "To your descendants I give this land, from the Wadi<sup>[e]</sup> of Egypt to the great river, the Euphrates—<sup>19</sup> the land of the Kenites, Kenizzites, Kadmonites, <sup>20</sup> Hittites, Perizzites, Rephaites, <sup>21</sup> Amorites, Canaanites, Girgashites and Jebusites."

Where do we see what God promises fulfilled when he says to Abraham I will be cut up and killed if I don't bring what I promised to pass?

#### GRACE - Gen 15.6

# GOD COMMITS HIMSELF <u>BEFORE</u> THE COVENANT SIGN OF CIRCUMCISION IS APPLIED TO ABRAHAM.

NOTE FOR FUTURE RECOLLECTION: for the sin of the Amorites has not yet reached its full measure. Gen 15.16

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> He also said to him, "I am the Lord, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land to take possession of it."

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> But Abram said, "Sovereign Lord, how can I know that I will gain possession of it?"

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>9</sup> So the Lord said to him, "Bring me a heifer, a goat and a ram, each three years old, along with a dove and a young pigeon."

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>10</sup> Abram brought all these to him, cut them in two and arranged the halves opposite each other; the birds, however, he did not cut in half. <sup>11</sup> Then birds of prey came down on the carcasses, but Abram drove them away.

Satan's first blow against "the seed of the woman"
Unsuccessful: Kingdom of God survives persecution
God raises up "another seed."

Compromise; distinction between the two lines breaks down (Gen 6.5)
Kingdom survives apostasy, syncretism, division, because of judgment—namely flood.
Kingdom of this world frustrated by ethnic/language barriers

Noah was a failed new beginning—resulting in Canaan **Another new beginning: ABRAHAM.**
