Mary Tavy Victory Memorial Recreation Ground & Coronation Hall




The hall & field are a vital community resource offering modern facilities & a calm space in the heart of the village.

 The Main Hall has a maximum total capacity of 250 people and theatre seating for 170 	 The field has a football pitch – currently home to Lamerton Football Club – with changing rooms for two teams
 Catering can be arranged for 100 people in the large Kitchen which was replaced in 2017 	 There are 2 hard pitches and a children's play area
• There is a large car park and separate area for disabled parking near the Main Entrance	 The field is home to the allotments and also hosts a series of tyre planters which have been adopted by members of the community
 There is a Lounge/Bar/Changing Room area. However, the Hall does not have a bar licence 	 There is also an outdoor gym (provided through a grant obtained by The Jubilee Group)
• The large Stage has full lighting and a sound-loop for hearing impaired guests. It will soon be enhanced with a projector	 There is a well-trodden path round the field and a lovely woodland walk
 The hall has a free wi-fi service provided via Airband 	 The Jubilee walk can be accessed at the end of the field to get to the top of the village and the Mary Tavy Inn
