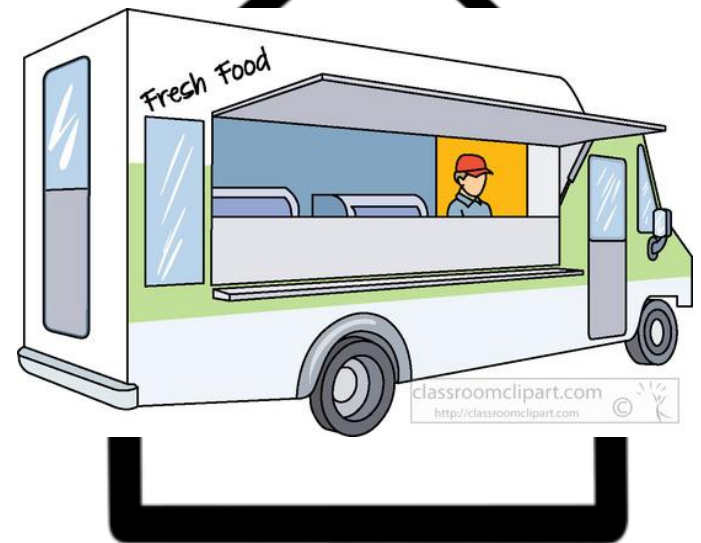
It's Still All About Jesus

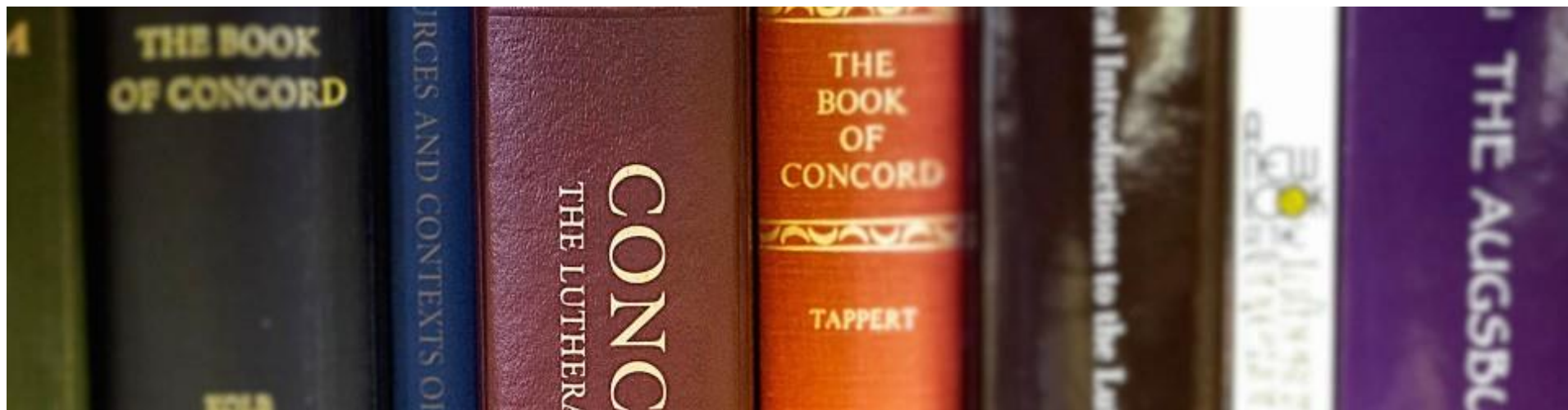

Goal #3 | CAPITAL PROJECTS

There is something special about gathering around the dinner table that builds a sense of community. The Camp Luther “dinner table” is special not only because of the joyful conversations and new friendships circled around a meal, but because campers, counselors, friends, and families gather in the midst of Christ himself.

Current Limitations:

- The Lodge portion of the facility built around 1920, has significant structural and operational concerns that need to be addressed.
- The Dining Hall added in 1979 is too small to meet the needs of current camp programs and guest groups.
- Meals are often served in shifts which limits opportunity for community gatherings.
- Kitchen equipment and facilities are outdated and in need of upgrading to improve quality and efficiency.

Project Under Consideration:

- Replace Dining Hall and Kitchen with a facility better suited to meet the needs of a growing ministry.
- Improve overall food service quality and efficiency.
- Expand space for inventory, rest rooms, packouts, and laundry.

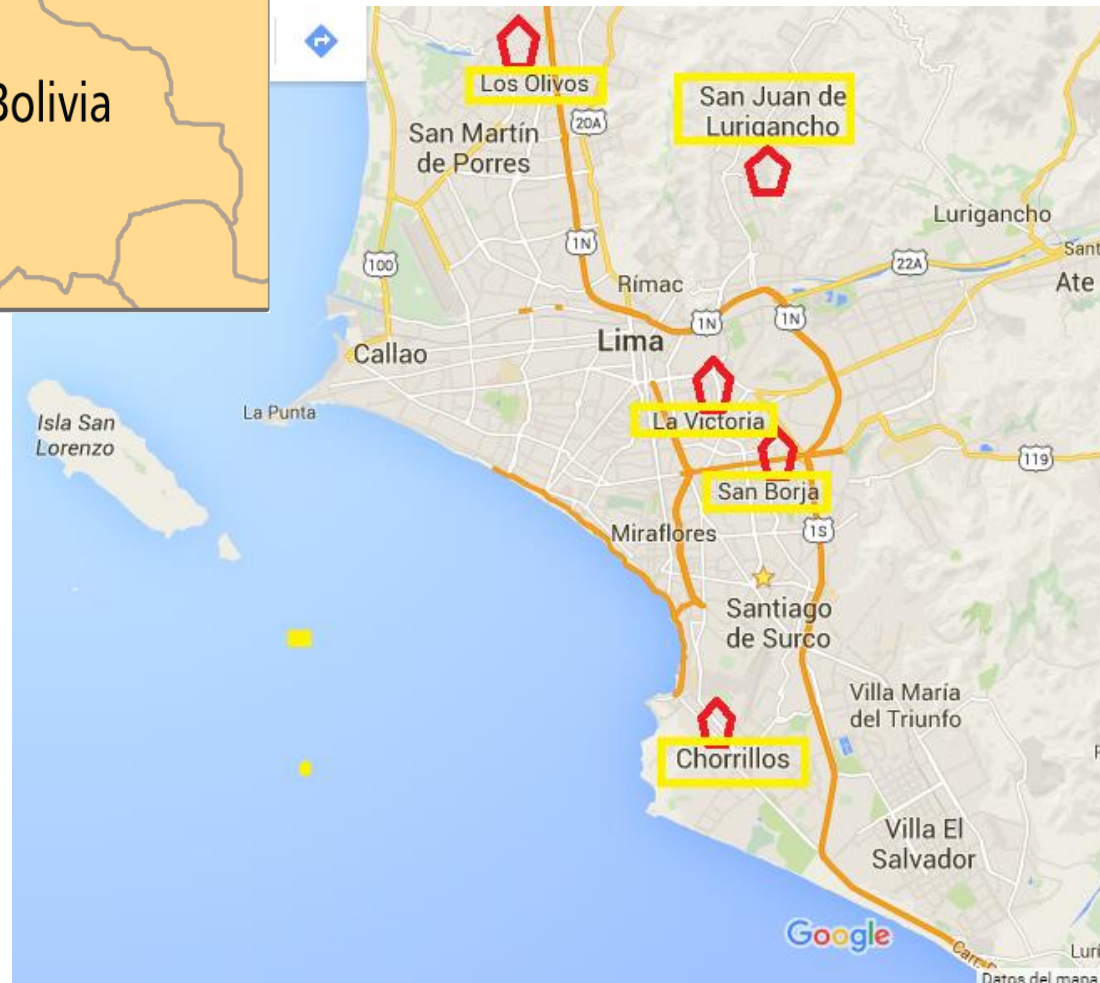
