

FERN ENGLISH 1906 - 1994

Fern Isabell English, 88, lifelong resident of Colfax Township, passed away Wednesday, May 11, at Huron Memorial Hospital of Bad Axe.

She was born Feb. 8, 1906 in Chandler Township, daughter of the late Duncan and Laura (Stewart) Campbell.

She married Ray English on Aug. 17, 1929 at the Methodist Parsonage in Elkon.

Mrs. English received her teaching certificate from County Normal and a bachelor's degree in education from Central Michigan University. She taught in several rural schools for 23 years, at Kinde Elementary for two years and at Elkon Elementary for four years, before retiring in 1968.

She was a member of the Elkon United Methodist Church, Huron County Retired Teachers Association, Pioneer Farm Bureau, a charter member of the Elkon Senior Citizens, a life member and past matron of the Order of the Eastern Star No. 431 Elkon Chapter.

Surviving are her husband, Ray; two sons, Alan and Don, both of Bad Axe; eight grandchildren and a sister, Helen Schultz of Bad Axe.

She was preceded in death by two brothers, Neil and Donald Campbell.

Funeral services were conducted Friday, May 13 at the Elkon United Methodist Church. The Rev. Sang Chun, pastor, officiated with burial in the Colfax Cemetery.
