Clerk's Report for **Tuesday 20 March 2018 to Monday 21 May 2018** (Points numbered according to the minutes of the last meeting.)

4. The Clerk posted the minutes to the website.
9. Cllr Hanks provided information regarding Lengthsman works. CDC Cllr Nigel Moor has confirmed all works for Naunton under the Lengthsman scheme will take place week commencing 24 September. Clerk has passed details through to Nigel Moor. Further works can still be added.

Information about Litter Picking initiatives was sent to Neil Vincent.

Next steps re: retaining access to rights of way is to research the affected roads and provide historical and user evidence of the right of way and have the path added to the Definitive Map, held Gloucestershire County Council (not the Ordnance survey map). The BHS runs free workshops (contact Hannah.marsh@bhs.org.uk). There is also a book 'Rights of Way - Restoring the Record' by Phil Wadey and Sarah Bucks.

10. The second and final payment towards the Village Hall refurbishment project has been made and the first increased precept payment has been received. The first loan repayment is in August.

Clerk has applied for VAT refund for 2017- 2018. Total refund is £494.28.

11. CDC Enforcement training. Clerk booked Cllr Chance for this training and Cllr Chance will report on the course.
12. The Clerk has placed order for new dog waste bin and the cheque is being presented at 21 May's meeting for signing. Budget was £210 but invoice is for £211.79 (£159.99 + VAT).
