- 2. All twirlers from all organizations are welcome. No membership or insurance is required to participate in an NBTA contest
- 3. Contestant Classification **No Double Entering.** NOVICE: Never won 5 first place awards in Novice level competition or first place in a higher division. BEGINNER: Never won 5 first place awards in Beginner level competition or first place in a higher
 - INTERMEDIATE: Never won 8 first place awards in Intermediate level competition or first place in a higher division.
- No gymnastics allowed body aerials, walkovers, cartwheels, butterflies, somersaults on the floor – penalty is disqualification.
- Protection Rule: Applies at local, state and regional competitions.
