**Job Description**

**PURPOSE:**  
Perform service, maintenance, repair, and installation of plumbing systems in residential, light commercial, educational, industrial, and healthcare facilities. Systems may include domestic water, sanitary, storm, natural gas, compressed air, steam, condensate, medical gas, plumbing fixtures, plumbing equipment, and backflow preventers. Experience is required. Salary and benefits will be determined based on years of experience and certifications.

**ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Install, repair, and maintain plumbing piping systems and components.
- Install, repair, and maintain plumbing fixtures.
- Install, repair, and maintain plumbing equipment.
- Test and certify backflow preventers.
- Test and repair pipe systems and fixtures for leaks.
- Troubleshoot systems to determine required repairs and maintenance.
- Ensure all installations, repairs, and maintenance meet code requirements.
- Mentors fellow employees to enhance their skill sets.
- Inspecting and testing plumbing systems for safety, functionality, and code compliance.
- Handling customer queries and responding to call outs.

- Troubleshooting and resolving problems.
- Must be willing to work in and out of St. Clair County.

**ADDITIONAL NOTES:**

- Watson Bros. Service Company, Inc. is a union affiliated shop with Plumbers Local 98 and Pipefitters Local 636. Applicants shall be union members or willing to become a member.
- Must be able to: Stand or walk for long periods of time during the regular work day; use arms and hands to reach for, handle and manipulate objects; lift and carry materials weighing 50 to 100 pounds; climb up and down ladders, work at high heights, scaffolds and other climbing devices; carry tools and equipment; work while in stooped, kneeling, crouched, and crawling positions; be able to see naturally or with correction, to safely perform designated tasks.
- Must be able to: Perform assigned tasks under all types of environmental and weather conditions including severe cold, extreme heat, wet or dry weather and high winds. Environmental conditions may include areas where toxic or caustics chemicals or fumes are in use or being stored. May be required to operate power tools
- Will be required to perform other duties as requested, directed or assigned.
