**HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

**Saturday, January 21st**

**AFC Divisional: Jacksonville at Kansas City. 4:30pm ET NBC**  
**2★ 2-team 6-point teaser (-125 or less) on KC -2.5 and PHI -1.5.**  
**KANSAS CITY 31 Jacksonville 22.**

Kansas City beat Jacksonville 27-17 at home (-9.5) on November 13th. The total in that game was 51.5. The Jags enter on a 6-game win streak (5-1 ATS) as they became just the 5th team ever to go from the worst record in the NFL to a division title. Last week they rallied from a 27-0 deficit to beat the Chargers 31-30 marking the 3rd largest comeback in playoff history. The Jags were -5 in TO's as teams are now just 7-169-1 straight up since 1989 with a -5 TO deficit. The Jags ranked No. 9 in offensive yards per play (regular season) and were No. 8 overall in ypp margin. However, Jacksonville did play one of the weaker schedules in the NFL this year. On the other side, the Chiefs were No. 1 in offensive yards per play and No. 1 overall in ypp margin. Like Jacksonville, KC also played one of the weaker schedules in the NFL (according to DVOA) as the AFC West did not live up to expectations this year. KC clinched the No. 1 seed in the AFC due to the Buffalo/Cincinnati game being cancelled as the Chiefs lost to both teams. However, KC did win their last 5 games of the regular season. Obviously, QB Patrick Mahomes has much more playoff experience than his counter-part Trevor Lawrence who threw 4 first half interceptions last week only to rebound in the second half. According to Marc Lawrence's Playbook, KC head coach Andy Reid is 29-6 SU (22-13 ATS) off a bye but Doug Pederson does know him well serving on his staff for 7 years. We lean OVER but prefer KC in a teaser.

**NFC Divisional: N.Y. Giants at Philadelphia. 8:15pm ET FOX.**  
**2★ 2-team 6-point teaser (-125 or less) on KC -2.5 and PHI -1.5.**  
**PHILADELPHIA 28 N.Y. Giants 21.**

This is the 3rd meeting between these two teams in just 5 weeks. Philadelphia went 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS vs the Giants in the two regular season meetings. Philly won 48-22 as 7-point road favorites on December 11th and then won 22-16 as 17-point home favorites on January 8th with the G-Men resting starters. Philly has owned the series taking 24 of the last 30 meetings. The Eagles come in off a bye and QB Jalen Hurts should be the healthiest he's been in more than a month. The Eagles were over-priced in the markets down the stretch as they failed to cover each of their last 4 games. However, they are 14-1 SU with Hurts as the starter this year. The Eagles ranked No. 2 in ypp margin and No. 3 in DVOA but did play one of the weakest schedules in the NFL. Meanwhile, the Giants were No. 24 in ypp margin and DVOA ranks them No. 21 overall (did play a tougher schedule than Philly). The Giants have been under-valued all season at 14-4 ATS which is the best mark in the NFL. We won on these pages last week in their upset over Minnesota. QB Daniel Jones was the first QB to have 300-plus passing, 2 TD's and 70-plus rushing in a playoff game. Similar to the KC game, we don't see much value on the side but do prefer Philly in a teaser.

**Sunday, January 22nd**

**AFC Divisional: Cincinnati at Buffalo. 3:00pm ET CBS.**

**1★ OVER 48. BUFFALO 28 Cincinnati 22.**

Obviously, these two met back on January 2nd in the MNF game that was cancelled due to Buffalo DB Damar Hamlin collapsing on the field. Hamlin has miraculously recovered and is recovering at the Bills facility almost daily. Buffalo was a 1-point road favorite in that game but trailed 7-3. Buffalo enters on a 8-game win streak. The Bills are No. 3 in ypp margin while DVOA and Sagarin rank them No. 1 overall in their power ratings (regular season). Last week, the Bills looked to be on cruise control early with a 17-0 lead over Miami. However, the Dolphins gave them quite a scare despite Buffalo easily winning the stats. Meanwhile, the Bengals also got quite the scare from a division rival as they held on to beat Baltimore. It's a game Cincinnati easily could've lost if not for the 98-yard fumble return TD in the fourth quarter which was a 14-point swing. Baltimore outgained Cincinnati 364-234. Cincinnati is 12-3 ATS in their last 15 games and are 12-1 ATS vs teams not named Baltimore. Cincinnati surprisingly ranks just No. 13 in ypp margin but DVOA ranks them No. 5 overall. Cincy QB Joe Burrow is on a 9-0 ATS run as an underdog but the Bengals continue to deal with injuries on their offensive line (OT Jonah Williams left last week's game with an injury). Tough fading Cincy QB Burrow so we lean with the OVER here as the early weather forecast isn't too bad for Buffalo in January (mid-30's, overcast, 12 mph wind).

**NFC Divisional: Dallas at San Francisco. 6:30pm ET FOX.**

**1★ SAN FRANCISCO (-3.5). SAN FRANCISCO 26 Dallas 21.**

Two of the most storied franchises in the NFC with so many memorable playoff match-ups. They met last year in the Wildcard with San Francisco winning 23-17 (+3.5). The Cowboys are at a disadvantage in this game from a situational aspect. The 49ers have a couple extra days rest after beating Seattle on Saturday and are playing at home for a 3rd straight week. Meanwhile, Dallas is off a MNF game and traveling for a 4th straight week! Dallas ranked No. 7 in ypp margin and No. 6 overall in DVOA in the regular season. Dak had not been playing well for the Cowboys with an interception in 7 straight games. However, he did play well (5 total TD's no turnovers) in Tampa as the Cowboys got their first road playoff win in 30 years. Meanwhile, the 49ers enter this game on a 11-game win streak (9-2 ATS). SF has the No. 4 yards per play offense and No. 4 yards per play defense while DVOA (advanced analytics site) ranks them No. 2 overall (No. 1 defense). However, the 49ers have played one of the easiest schedules in the NFL this season. QB Brock Purdy now has a 16-to-3 TD-to-INT ratio in his last 7 starts. Everyone keeps waiting for him to have that "rookie" performance but the reality is Kyle Shanahan is an elite play-caller and the 49ers have elite talent surrounding him. The 49ers have won 13 of their last 14 home games and have covered 12 of those games.
