- Exhibits must be the sole work of the exhibitor except where noted.
- There will be a \$1.00 fee per entered item. Premium entries in Fine Art and Photography will be charged a \$10.00 fee per item. Entry fees are due with your printed information from your online entry. Make checks or money orders payable to Verde Valley Fair Association. If you would like to enter a "Display Only" item there is no charge and no ribbon or premium will be awarded. Entry fees are not refundable.
- All applications for entry must be made online and must be complete. Should you need assistance with the online process, staff will be available to help you. Contact the Fair Office at 928-634-3290.
- Completed forms, fees and entries must be received by the deadline as stated above.
- Fair Management is not responsible for finding errors in entries. Exhibits which have been incorrectly entered may, at the discretion of the superintendent of the department, be transferred to their proper class before judging.
- Superintendents will make all assignments for space for the exhibits and will arrange the exhibits.
- Each exhibitor may exhibit a maximum of two items in each class. Additional identical or similar items <u>may not</u> be entered in classes listed as "other please describe".
- Classes may be combined where closely related at the Superintendent and Judge's discretion, providing an insufficient number of entries in any one lot does not provide adequate competition.
- The Fair reserves the right to refuse entries or prohibit the exhibition of any article, for any reason whatsoever.

- Judging will be done prior to the opening of the Fair. Judging will not be open to the public or exhibitors.
- It shall be at the sole discretion of the Judge(s) whether the exhibits are awarded blue, red or white ribbons and corresponding
  premium money. If any entries are judged not worthy of a premium, the Judge(s) are instructed to not make an award.
  Judges decisions are final.
- Awards will be paid as follows to the exhibitor named on the entry form: Best of Show: \$10.00, Blue Ribbon: \$3.00, Red Ribbon: \$2.00, White Ribbon: \$1.00
- The General Rules and Regulations of the Verde Valley Fair will govern exhibition entries.
- All exhibitors will be under the control and direction of the Fair Management, but Verde Valley Fair Association, Inc. it's officers, directors, agents or employees will in no case be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may occur. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may occur to him, his officers, agents, employees or exhibits during the Fair. The exhibitor shall indemnify the Fair against any and all legal proceedings in regard to the above and against damage or injury to any other person or property, caused by the exhibitor, his officers, agents, employees or animals.
- The Verde Valley Fair Association, Inc. reserves the right to use any and all photographs and or video taken during the Fair for publicity purposes.

- Exhibitors must be Arizona residents
- Items entered must not have been entered in previous Verde Valley Fair
- Entries must be labeled (on the item) with artist's name, address and telephone number.
- All entries must be adequately protected and properly framed with wire hangers.
- Insufficient entries in one or more classes will necessitate grouping with similar classes.
- Entries must be original work of entrant created within the last 3 years
- Entries must be ready for display.
