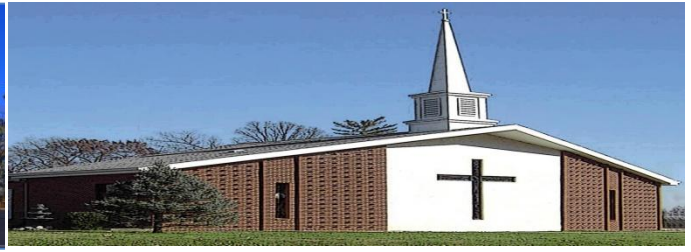



FROM THE PASTOR

July 1, 2018

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Mark 5:21-43

Dear St. Pius X and St. Anthony Church Family,

Peace! I know I am repeating myself, but I love the scriptures and I think some good prayer time for anyone can start by just asking ourselves, "What is my favorite bible story or scripture phrase *and why* is it my favorite?" I hope it is agreeable to everyone, but I would love to use a little of our bulletin space each week to reflect upon the gospel we will be hearing at Sunday Mass. This week, I love the humble faith of the suffering woman who comes to Jesus for healing, but doesn't want to bother Him, so she just sneaks a touch. She says, in Mark 5:28, "If I but just touch his clothes, I shall be cured." Her humility in not wanting to disturb Jesus' schedule, reminds me of the story about the simple farm mare who didn't dare think of ever winning a KY Derby, but simply being in it once. She said, "I know I don't have a chance of winning a KY Derby, but it would be great even to just get a chance to show up at the gate with the big guys." So, one of my favorite bible stories is this one about her desire to simply get close to Jesus. She knows her Savior. She knows that even just getting close to Jesus will bring about a change in her condition. And it does! Our own drawing near to Jesus will change us too. I do not want any spectacular vision or miracle of Jesus. I just simply want to know He is close. So I need to come up and walk with Him in the crowd, making no scene or appearance, but just staying close enough to touch Him, or let Him touch me. We do come close to Him through our 1) daily quiet time with Him, 2) our reading of His Word, 3) our praying of Mass with Him, and 4) our compassionate service to Him in our suffering brothers or sisters. Any one of these ways is at least a beginning, and anything with Jesus *begun in faith*, God will *bring to fruit* (Remember, mustard seeds!). Something to pray about this week.
