**A Note from Rick:** Another week of steady markets at TLA. The Tuesday sale prices were very consistent with previous weeks with the exception of calves. Calf prices continued to trend softer, with the better end of the calves bringing from \$70-\$90. I see this market continuing to struggle with feed costs on the rise. Dairy cattle prices have been very consistent across the country for quite some time now. We had just short of 200 head total at our January Springer Sale and that's down a little from our normal monthly sale. Prices averaged about \$50 higher than the December sale, but that is not as strong as October and November prices. I know I sound like a broken record, but there just isn't much new to report on the dairy side of things. Consignments are rolling in for the Spring Draft Horse Auction and anticipation is starting to build. At TLA we are taking January and February to clear out 2020 and get ready for 2021. The schedule is set for the year and we are hoping and praying that we can get back to normal. We didn't know how lucky we were and will never take for granted the packed stands and excitement of a good horse sale again. See you at TLA!
