Students: Below is a list of 10 questions. Please select <u>three questions</u>, and on a separate sheet of paper, write or type your answers.

Each answer must be a minimum of 100 words, and no more than 300 words. Please attach your answers and submit with Page 1 of the application. Thank you.

- 1. Describe your best classroom experience while attending FHS...the one that had the most impact on you. Was it the students? The teacher? The class content? Your fellow students? Explain.
- 2. What was the greatest challenge you faced in high school not related to academics and how did you work through it?
- 3. Describe one of your "quirks" (that you know is a quirk or that others have told you it is). Why is it a quirk? Explain how it originated and is part of what makes you unique.
- 4. In your opinion, what is the most significant social/cultural issue high school teenagers are dealing with today?
- 5. You are required to spend your first year out of high school in either the past or in the future. What year would you pick and why?
- 6. One-third of college students fail out before the end of their freshman year. List some of the qualities and skills you believe are critical to be successful in college.
- 7. Explain in detail the impact of social media in your high school years and how it has affected you (positively or negatively).
- 8. Describe a friend of yours who is very different from you, and something you have learned from that person.
- 9. Tell us about ONE thing that makes you really happy.
- 10. You just reached one million likes on your original YouTube video. What's the video about? Who is in it?
