e) Lac Ste. Anne County – September 12th, 2017 letter on response to our June 12th, 2017 letter on a cost share of Township Road 540. The Summer Village had proposed a 50/50 cost share on the entire project in our June letter, and the County has counter offered with a 50/50 cost share on their ½ mile portion and a 75/25 cost share on our 1 ½ mile portion, with the project being considered by the County for 2018. As there is no cost estimates attached to this letter I would suggest Council approve in principal the cost share subject to final confirmation once costs are known. For example, if this total project ends up to be \$600,000 (\$150,000 per ½ mile) the costs would be:

LSAC: \$75,000 + \$112,500 for a total of \$187,500 SS: \$75,000 + \$337,500 for a total of \$412,500

If we were to just do our 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles at \$150,000 per $\frac{1}{2}$ mile it would cost us \$450,000 and the first $\frac{1}{2}$ might not get done at all!
