NOVEMBER 2018 CULTURAL ARTS COMMITTEE REPORT:

The annual MCPS Cultural Arts Showcases were held on October 2nd, 3rd, and 11th. A total of 41 different artists/shows were presented; eight of these were new shows this year (meaning that they were just auditioned and approved in September by the Superintendent's Committee for Performances in MCPS.)

There are now over 150 performers listed in the MCPS Performing Arts Catalogue, though many do not participate in the Showcases due to scheduling conflicts. However, each year there is a different mix of performers in the Showcases and many performances have been taped for cultural arts representatives to view online. I also distributed other important information for cultural arts reps, including directions for joining the PTArts e-list. Attendance at the Showcases this year usually ranged from 15 to 25 audience members. Only a total of 20 schools were represented (some sent several people), which continues to concern us as this is only one-tenth of the schools in Montgomery County!
