Their mission is "to walk alongside our brothers and sisters experiencing chronic homelessness and connect them to services and agencies" with the goal of ensuring their journey succeeds in ending their homeless experience. Last year Our Father's Table saw more than 95% of those engaged in Project Restoration continued to remain in stable housing as well as clean and sober one year after entering this program.
