

SNOW REMOVAL PRIORITIZED

EARLIEST: Clear driveways with truck blade at all homes to allow homeowners to exit garages.

Rotate between the four streets as the starting point for each snow storm. (Velvet Ct, Doeskin Ct, Creekwood Ct, Seton Place)

NEXT: Clear all other driveways with truck blade to allow homeowners to exit garages

NEXT: Clear sidewalks to front doors with shovels or snow blower

NEXT: Clear all driveways of remaining snow by shoveling or snow blower

NEXT: Clear sidewalks on streets in front of homes with shovels or snow blower

NEXT: Clear 6' wide path on sidewalks on Saddlerock Road with shovels or snow blower

SNOW IS NOT TO BE REMOVED FROM STREETS UNLESS REQUESTED BY THE ASSOCIATION BOARD

With snowy weather on the horizon, it is time to remind you of our snow removal policy. Our association's snow removal policy sets guidelines which are generally based on snowfall accumulation:

(a) one inch but less than three inches – clear entry way, steps, and a path along the side of driveway to sidewalks;

(b) three inches or more – in addition to (a), clear driveways and sidewalks.

The particular circumstances of each storm will be considered when the board coordinates snow removal with Green Thumb. If the forecast calls for overnight snow, please park vehicles in the garage to the extent possible to aid the snow removal efforts.
