I wouldn't call a six month renovation of our building having fun, but it was all worth it!

I want to personally thank the Giles County Public Library Board of Trustees for their hard work in raising money and helping to get the renovation project completed. I also want to thank all the staff of the library for their hard work, patience, and fortitude during this past year to get to this point in time. We have worked very closely with each other during this time, and if you visited our temporary location across the street this past summer, you know we worked very closely!

I have been the Director of Giles County Public Library for the past two years. You may or may not know that my background was in banking, motherhood, and volunteering, not libraries. It has been a great learning experience to be involved in all that goes into the operation of a public library. With the help of the State of Tennessee, I am learning a lot more about the operation of a library. The State offers a three-year Public Library Manager Institute training program for

library directors without a master's degree in library science. I applied for the program and was accepted in June of 2013. It is an intense week of training each year and continuing education each month throughout the year. When the three-year training program is over, I will be a Certified Public Library Manager in the State of Tennessee.

Of course, education and learning never ceases. That's why libraries are so important. A library is the center of lifelong learning and education. You can find information on almost any topic at the library, whether it be in our books on the shelves, or on our public computers on the internet.

The Tennessee Electronic Library (TEL) is a huge database for all residents of the state to use. It offers Homework Help, such as articles and primary resources, language learning, literature resource center, and the World Book Encyclopedia. It has research help with magazine and journal articles and The Tennessean. It has test prep for ACT, SAT, etc., job search and interview tips, resume writing, and genealogy. If you haven't been introduced to the Tennessee R.E.A.D.S. program for E-books, audio books and streaming videos, come by the library and let us help you learn to download to your device. By the time you get your newsletter, our library will be a member of the Overdrive Advantage Program. This program allows us to purchase

e-books for the R.E.A.D.S. program that only our library customers can access and download. Therefore, this should reduce waiting times for popular items on R.E.A.D.S. and in the library. It is a great program and very convenient.

The library has had lots of requests for computer classes. With the help of Bo Harvey, we are offering beginning computer classes. Look for the dates and times later in the newsletter and call or come by to sign up for the classes.

We are looking forward to the New Year and what 2015 brings. The Giles County Public Library staff wishes you all the best for the New Year.

Starting Sunday, January 18th and running until Saturday, January 31st (the last two weeks of January), we will have an amnesty period.



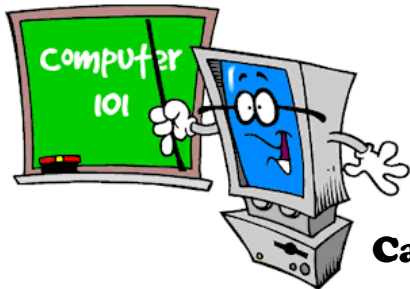
Overdue items returned during this period will not have any late fees.

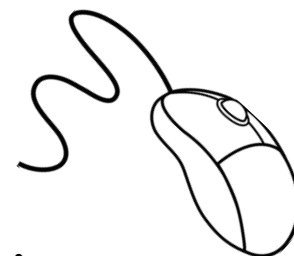

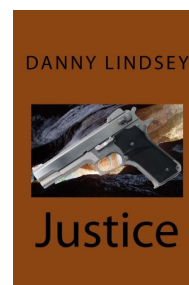


**Author Event—Danny Lindsey**

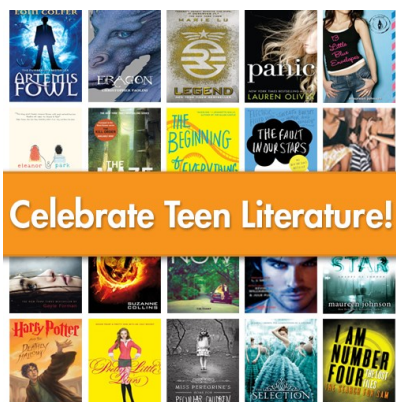
Did you know that the Giles County Public Library has 4 Simple Touch Nooks for customers to check out? Each Nook is loaded with a variety of books. Two of our Nooks are geared towards juvenile and young adult level, while the other two have a variety of adult titles.

Each Nook is available for check-out for the normal 2 week lending period. If there are not any reserve holds on the device, it may be renewed twice (for 2 weeks each period). If returned late, these devices have a fine of \$1.00 per day that they are overdue.

Looking for the titles available on each Nook? Title lists are available at the front desk at the Giles County Public Library.

The State Library and Archives is commencing the relationship by sharing Tennessee death records from 1908 through 1959 with Ancestry.com and its users. This database included 1.2 million digital images and indexes 3.4 million names that appear in those records.
