That temporary rules of conduct for the July 28, 2020 Board of Trustee's meeting shall be as follows (It is unknown at the time of the preparation and posting of this Agenda whether the Governor will extend his Executive Orders to include the date of this meeting. Consequently, the Agenda and the temporary rules of procedure have been prepared on the assumption that the Executive Order is in effect for this meeting):

On March 20, 2020 the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive Order 2020-10 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 8) which, among other things instituted a "Stay at Home" order through April 7, 2020 and prohibited public and private gatherings or more than 10 people. On April 1, 2020 the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive Order 2020-19 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 17) which, among other things extended the "Stay at Home" order through April 30, 2020. On April 30, 2020 the Governor extended the "Stay at Home" order through May 30, 2020 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 33). On May 29, 2020, the Governor extended the "Stay at Home" order No. 39) and on June 27, 2020 COVID-19 Executive Order 44 extended the order through July 27, 2020. The following temporary rules are intended to comply with the Executive Orders and satisfy certain Illinois statutory requirements for actions by the Board of Trustees.

At least a quorum of the Board of Trustees who are attending the July 28, 2020 Board of Trustees meeting will be required to attend physically, complying with all social distancing rules, at the appointed meeting location and the other Trustee may attend by means of telephonic attendance, including but not limited to a phone connection. Members of the Public may participate in the meeting, telephonically, as provided below. In the event member(s) of the Public appear at the meeting site, they will be requested to participate in

the meeting telephonically. Appointed staff and consultants of the District will participate telephonically.

The platform for electronic/telephonic attendance at the Board of Trustees meeting will be arranged in advance by the President, or designee, and will be communicated to each Trustee at least five days prior to the commencement of the meeting. The telephonic platform shall allow all Trustees to speak and listen simultaneously to the proceedings. The format of the agenda for the regular meeting shall remain the same, that is, shall be called in the same order as contained in the existing Board of Trustees rules.
