
## Progress Report – 1 October 2014 (updated March 2016)

## rian Trailhea

The trailhead consists of 15 individual parking spaces and a day use cul-de-sac for parking 5-6 more rigs. It is located 10 miles South of Kyburz CA, off Hwy 50 on Silver Fork Road.

This is an equestrian community project funded by donations and developed by local volunteer labor.

The planning and construction of this site resulted from an extended partnership between the Elegant Ears Mule Assn., the Mother Lode Unit of BCHC and the US Forest Service.





## PHASE I

2011-2012: study & approval processes 2013: survey, grading & trail extension to new trailhead

2014: gravel 12 spaces & bridge repair

The trailhead opened in June 2014 after \$20,000 was raised to pay for grading & partial gravel & signage & bridge repair. All funds were donated and used to purchase materials. In-kind donations of heavy equipment usage totaled another \$4665. A total of 1284 hours of volunteer labor was contributed.

PHASE II: \$12,000 funds are needed for gravelling the day use cul-de-sac. \$19,000 funds are needed for gravelling the .3 mile entry road 10N94. Phase III: \$3,000 cost increase for price of gravel in Dec 2015. Cost Changes since 2014: \$5,000 to \$15,000 to correct 3 winters of erosion.

- 1. Hwy 50 to Kyburz CA
- 2. South on Silver Fork Road; go 9 miles 4. Right on dirt road 10N94; go .3 mile
- 3. Cross Fitch Rantz Bridge; go .2 mile
- 5. Gravel marks the completed parking area
