March 25, 2018 Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord Mk 14:1 - 15:47

Jesus said, "Amen, I say to you, one of you will betray me, one who is eating with me."

In today's Gospel passage from St. Mark we read about the Last Supper and the last events and moments in the earthly life of Jesus. We learn about the pride and wrath of the chief priest and scribes; the envy and lack of understanding of people about why Jesus was so loved; the betrayal of a close friend; the wisdom and counsel of Jesus for his close friends; the lack of courage and fortitude of beloved followers; and the lust for power and brutality of the Roman authorities. We also learn of the love of Jesus for those who hated him, who lost faith in him, who killed him and for all of us. It is a story we have heard many times. It is a story that has been repeated over and over again since the Resurrection of Jesus. Before we are quick to condemn all involved in the story, we must ask if it is a story that has played out, to some extent, in each of our lives? Theses last few days of Lent and the celebration of the Triduum [Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil] are a good time to ask "Have I, in some way, betrayed Jesus?"
