The parade is at night, so all entries need to be lighted! Please specify if you are walking or riding, whether it is a float or a vehicle, and whether you choose to be judged or non-judged. Thank you!

<u>WALKERS</u> - Anyone walking will need to meet at the corner of 3rd and Walnut (*First Christian Church*). DO NOT line up at the Fire Department or you will not be able to join the parade.

<u>FLOATS</u> - Entries will be judged by randomly pre-selected volunteers. Floats will be judged on creativity, originality, and depiction of theme. All floats, cars/trucks, horseback, etc., need to be lined up at the North Lake Park (*in front of the Recreation Center*) at the times stated above. Remember, your float should <u>NOT</u> include Santa Claus. He will be arriving at the end of the parade.

1st place float: \$100 in Chamber Bucks 2nd place: \$50 in Chamber Bucks 3rd place: \$25 in Chamber Bucks
